



## Multi language sites in TYPO3

There are two concepts for working with multiple language websites in TYPO3. This is the topic of today's tip and the first thing I'm going to do is to outline the difference of these concepts so you'll better understand which way you should go yourself.

### 1: The "Two-Tree" concept

This is the "old" way to do it. This does not imply "old-fashioned" as if this is an inferior way to the new possibility! It just fits another purpose.
